- **Road Race** - A 35 mile clockwise loop starting in Newburg on quiet, scenic rural roads through the Mark Twain National Forest, traversing the Big and Little Piney River watersheds. The most scenic and challenging road course in the state.

- **Newburg, Missouri:** Exit #179 at Doolittle on I-44. Travel south 3 miles on Highway T to the railroad tracks in Newburg.
